

STARS EVEN GAMES WITH DAYTON TEAM

Hitting Features 2nd Game of Marcos Series at Mack Park.

Timely hitting by Hewett, Lyons and Wesley of the Detroit Stars enabled them to even the series with the Dayton Marcos at Mack park Sunday afternoon, taking the second game, 10 to 5.

Lane of the visitors, after gaining a four-run lead in the first two innings, allowed a single and a pass to Hewitt and Lyons, respectively. Wesley hit the third ball pitched for one of the longest hom-

ers ever seen at the park. Petway took a share of the batting honors in the same session, placing a perfect bunt down the third baseline which allowed two runners to score.

Brown and Hill upheld the fielding honors, perfect throwing shutting off several attempted scores.
