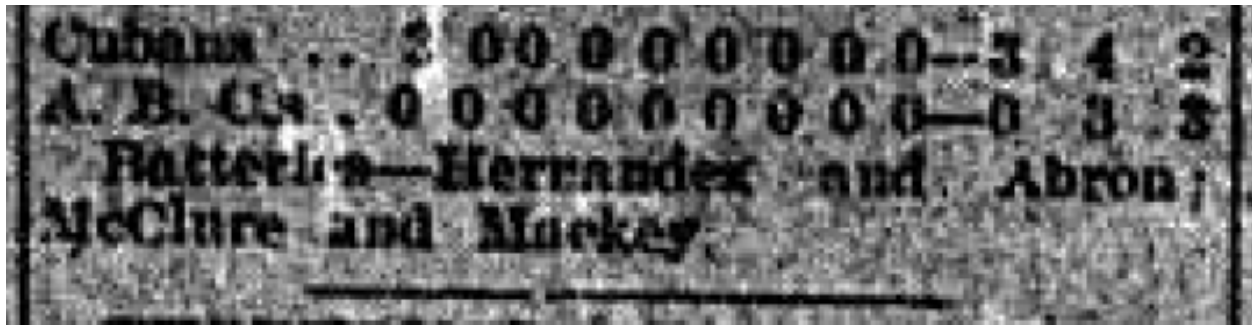


CUBANS BLANK A. B. C.S AT CINCINNATI, 3 TO 0
