

DETROIT STARS ON A RAMPAGE; SLAUGHTER JACKSON PITCHERS

DETROIT, Mich. (Special).—Jaxon Independents of Jackson, Mich., were slaughtered by the Detroit Stars, Sunday at Mack Park, before a record crowd, 23 to 0.

Cash, the mainstay of the Jackson pitching corps, was injured by a pitched ball in the second inning and forced to retire from the game. The Detroiters proceeded to maul his successors to all parts of the park and surrounding territory. Ted Blount's employes amassed a total of 21 hits during the afternoon, several of which were extra basers. Hewitt helped himself to five clean safeties out of five times at bat, Lyons again shone brightly at bat, knocking out a triple and a homer, the latter being a drive to deep center, the ball staying in the park. Wesley added a four-baser to his string, knocking the ball far out of the park.

The Detroit pitchers allowed but one of the visitors to reach third base.

The stars will tackle a real foe for five games, beginning Saturday next, the Cuban Stars.
