

## A. B. C.s AND CUBANS SPLIT IN TWIN BILL

Indianapolis, Ind., Sunday.—By hitting the ball hard in the second game at Washington park the A. B. C.'s grabbed off honors in this scrap and were able to split even in a twin bill with the Cuban Stars. The Cuban outfit took the first contest, 6 to 1, while the local club won the second, 10 to 2.

The A.'s came from behind to annex the second battle. The islanders got away to a three-run lead in the first inning and for a while it looked like a double defeat for Taylor's gang. However, the Indianapolis team soon started to hitting and chased a run over in the second and then five more in the third. Not contented, they brought their total to 9 in the fifth and then scored another in the seventh. The game was called at the end of the seventh on account of the early closing law.
