

BOLDEN TAKES CONTROL OF CAMDEN BALL PARK

Darby, Pa., Nov. 5.—Ed Bolden journeyed to Camden last week and made the final deal in taking over the Camden ball park on a long term lease. This is the opening wedge in arrangements for a bigger season next year. This puts Hilldale in complete control of Camden and blocks the interference of inferior teams. Hilldale will build ticket booths, tear down the old bleachers and build new ones, strengthen and cover the grand stand and make one of the best ball parks in the state of New Jersey.

After the schedule is complete Ed Bolden will assemble his men in the South next spring, tour through Jacksonville, Birmingham, Atlanta, New Orleans, Norfolk and Washington and bring to Philadelphia the fastest team in the country with an open challenge to meet all comers.

Hilldale has had the busiest and most successful season in her history, having played 140 games, losing 36 and tying 6.
