

## AMERICAN GIANTS FOUND DETROIT HURLERS, WINNING 8 TO 3

Detroit, Mich., Saturday.—The Detroit Stars dropped the first of the series to the Chicago American Giants, 8 to 3. The visitors landed on the local twirlers for 12 hits for 19 bases. MacDonald started for the Stars, but was relieved by Cooper in the second. Brown, for Chicago, allowed but four hits, two each to Lyons and Warfield. DeMoss and Gans each had a perfect day at bat, the former getting a single, two doubles and a pair of sacrifice flies in five trips to the plate, while Gans got two singles and a pair of triples.

Torrienti and Lyons robbed each other of sure triples by sensational catches. Torrienti was also robbed of a single in the seventh by Higgins' wonderful running one-hand catch.
