

PARKESBURG WINNER OF 16-INNING GAME

PARKESBURG, Pa., July 19. Parkesburg Iron Company took an 16-inning game from the Cuban Stars here today by the score of 3 to 2. The game at times scintillated with dazzling plays and at others was featured by errors on easy chances. Juneo, who pitched for the Cuban Stars, went the full distance while Malloy, who worked for the P. I. Company, was relieved in the thirteenth by Touchstone.

The visitors were the first to score when they pushed one over in the first inning on an error, a hit and a fly to the outfield. Parkesburg tied it up in the second on a hit and a couple of errors. After that the teams battled each other to a standstill until the fifth, when the Cubans bunched two hits and a sacrifice and scored another run. In the half of the fifth the Ironmen tied it up again on an error by Valdes and a hit by Kalkwin. In the final frame the visitors went out in order, but White came through with a two base hit that almost cleared the left field fence for a home run. He went to third on Touchstone's infield out and scored

in Popolock's strike that was too hot for Jones to handle. Irving's brilliant one-handed pickup of Valdes' grounder in the twelfth was a leading feature.
