

AMERICAN GIANTS TIE BACHARACHS

Rube Foster's American Giants and the Bacharach Giants battled to a 3 to 3 tie at the American League Park yesterday afternoon in the first of a two-game series to settle the colored team baseball championship of the country.

The Bacharachs counted a brace of markers in the second round, and the Western nine evened matters in the fourth. "Cannon Ball" Redding, of the Bacharachs, and Slim Sykes, of the Americans, staged a pitcher's duel for the remainder of the fracas. Hostilities were ended in the ninth because of darkness when the Bacharachs had the bases full with one out.
