

MORNING BATTLE SCHEDULED; FAST CONTEST WON BY LOCALS YESTERDAY

Tom Downey's Crew Thrash
Colored Giants 8 to 5; Hard
Tussles Expected.

DOWNEY'S San Diego nine beat
the Alexander Giants of New
York, 8 to 5, yesterday in the
stadium. The Giants had
hard luck in the first inning,

their pitcher, Ross, letting in seven tallies. Mooney was put in, and held the local nine down to one score for the remainder of the game. Thurston, the home slabman, allowed the darkies to get past his delivery for five runs.

After the first frame, the game was dull until the last of the sixth. Meyer flied to Davis, Davis caught the fly and pegged to Forts, at short, who tossed the ball to Mooney, completing a fast double play. In the first of the seventh, Thurston let up on his pressure, and Davis, Mooney and Curtis legged it for three scores. Some fast work for the local lads brought in a run by Compton. This ended the scoring.

Tomorrow a double-header is scheduled in the stadium. The same nines will play at 10 a. m. and at 2:15 p. m. The Alexander Giants will be reinforced by Hubbard at the mound and Downs at short, from the Lincoln Giants.

This game promises to be the closest battle yet staged between the two nines, as the Giants have shown

a marked improvement, especially in yesterday's game. The husky Hubbard will not find Downey's boys an easy mark, though.
