

"BLACK PANTHERS" DEFEAT OILERS IN 14 INNINGS, 3 TO 2

The Black Panthers won Saturday, an exciting fourteen-inning contest, the first game of a series of three with the Beaumont Black Exporters, leaders in the Texas Negro League. Score, 3-2.

Forest pitched excellent ball for the Oilers until the fourteenth inning, when a single by L. Jones of the Panthers followed by a fumble by Storey, shortstop of the Oilers, unsteadled him. J. Hill followed with a double and the game was over.

Fielding by Lopez, the Cuban second baseman of the Panthers, and W. Jones at shortstop, featured the pitchers' duel between Forest and Harris.

The same teams play a double header today, the first game starting at 3 o'clock.

A big crowd, including many white fans, saw Saturday's game.
