

NORRISTOWN WINS PITCHERS' BATTLE FROM HILLDALE

NORRISTOWN, Pa., June 23 (Special).—Norristown defeated Hilldale in a ten-inning pitchers' battle here today, by 2 to 1. Kepner's careful pitching was the big asset. He allowed but five scattered hits, no two coming in the same inning.

Hilldale scored their run in the seventh, when Johnson tripled to deep centre and scored on Lundy's sacrifice fr. Agnew tied the score in the eighth when he beat out an infield hit, stole second and scored on Spalding's timely single. The game was won in the tenth after one man was retired. Agnew, Poploski and Spalding producing successive singles.
