MILLVILLE RALLY

WAS ONE SHY

Threw Scare Into Bacharach
Giants in the Ninth.

BUT COULD ONLY
CHASE TWO OVER

Cashman Hit Home Run in the
Fourth But There Was Nobody
On the Bases.

Millville's ninth inning rally fell one run shy of evening the figures with the Bacharach Giants at Inlet Park yesterday, the final count showing the figures 4 to 3 against them. With Helfrich on third and two down, Hopkins made a valiant effort to clout the old pill to safe territory. He raised a high fly that dropped into Brown's glove over near the right field foul line. Harkness had a similar opportunity just before him, but Lloyd scooped his roller and tossed him out at first. It was a big chance to lose, but the boys did their best and failed.

"Rube" Cashman raised the stands when he crashed one of Wickware's fast ones over the left field fence in the fourth inning, tying up the score. The ball sailed away over the electric wires. It was a terrific wallop and it was a shame the bases weren't loaded.

Millville played a rather listless game in comparison to the exhibition

put up against the Brooklyn Royal Giants Wednesday evening. The boys could not get going right and enacted a number of misplays that helped considerably in their downfall.

Howard pitched good enough ball to win. He allowed eight hits, one half of them being obtained by Taylor, but he made one terrible mistake. In the fourth with two down he walked the pitcher on four pitched balls. Poles, the next man up, whaled a single to right that counted two of them. That was his tough inning.

The Scoring.

Poles walked in the first. Helfrich threw badly on Shivley's bunt and both were safe. Handy fanned. Lloyd hit to Peterson who threw to Hopkins, getting Poles at the plate. Taylor singled, scoring Shivley. Brown was tossed out by Seiferman.

In the fourth with one down, Cashman hit over the left field fence for the circuit.

In their half, Taylor led off with a hit. Brown also hit safely. Howard played Hutchinson's bunt to Seiferman, retiring Brown. Gatewood lined to Nelson. Howard pitched four straight balls to Wickware, loading the bases. Poles singled sharply to right, scoring Taylor and Hutchinson. Shivley fanned.

In the fifth Ned Robinson dropped Handy's fly. Lloyd bunted and Cashman tossed the ball to Howard retiring him at first. Taylor singled, for the third time, scoring Handy. Brown flied to Robinson. Hutchinson walked. Gatewood flied to Harkness.

In the ninth, Nelson popped to Lloyd. Cashman drew a pass, so did Seiferman. Helfrich singled, scoring

Cashman. Harkness hit to Lloyd, who threw him out, Seiferman scoring. Hopkins lifted a high fly to Brown. The tabulation:
