Art Summers to Take American Team Out for Basketball Series

Art Summers will again pilot the American all-star baseball team in a fall series of games. He will open the season with a three-game series with the crack Hilldale club of Darby, considered one of the best colored baseball teams in the East.

The opening game will be played on the Hilldale grounds at Darby, Saturday, October 4; the following day the All Stars will travel to Paterson, N. J., where they meet the crack "Silk Sockers." It is Summers's intention to play their second game with the Hilldalers at the Phillies Ball Park on Thursday, October 9.

Summers will have one of the best teams on the field he has taken out for several seasons. He will rely on Shawkey, of New York, and Pennock, of Boston, to do the twirling, with Wally Schang and Mayer holding the big mitt. Wally Pepp will hold the first sack down, Young, of Detroit, playing at second; Blackburne, of the the Phillies, blocking the third sack.

The fielders of the American stars this year will be Strunk, of the Athletics; Witt, also of Connie Mack's aggregation; Bobby Roth, of Boston, in right field; Peckinpaugh, of the Yankees, holding down the shortstop position.
