

WILLIAMS PITCHED FINE GAME

And Patched Up Beloit Leaguers Won From Monarchs, 6 to 2

Pitching a masterful game in the face of a patched up team back of him Davy Williams was given excellent support at Sewell park yesterday and the Beloit Leaguers won from the Kansas City Monarchs by a score of 6 to 2. Smith was the offering of the dusky lads and his portside heaves were to the liking of the Leaguers.

With "Red" Heriott out of the game for a few days, Tom Blodgett was sent to the initial sack and from the way he played there is a strong suspicion that he at least has a sorrel topped relative. Darrow played excellently in the backstop position, and in fact the whole Beloit team played winning ball.

The game in detail:

FIRST INNING

Monarch—Portuondo struck out. McNair whiffed three times. Mendez doubled to right. Donaldson went out, Williams to Blodgett. No runs. One hit.

Beloit—Walker out, Portuondo to Washington. Dimond flew out to Mendez. Horan fouled out to Rodriguez. No runs. No hits.

SECOND INNING

Monarchs — Washington grounded to Blodgett. Mathall out, Walker to Blodgett. Blackburn flew out to Hogue. No runs. No hits.

Beloit—Blodgett flew to Blackburn. Hart flew to McNair. Williams out, Smith to Washington. No runs. No hits.

THIRD INNING

Monarchs—Rodriguez doubled to left.

Smith struck out. Portuondo singled through short. McNair hit to short, who threw to Dimond. Running McNair and Rodriguez before him, Dimond threw low to Darrow and Rodriguez scored. Portuondo was caught off third, Darrow to Hart. Mendez retired, Walker to Blodgett. One run. Three hits.

Beloit—Hogue hit safe inside the first base line and stole second. Darrow out, Smith to Washington. Culver flew out to Donaldson. Walker drew a free pass. Dimond hit safe to center, scoring Hogue. Horan hit a hot one to Smith, scoring Dimond. Blodgett singled to center, scoring Horan. Hart out, Mendez to Washington. Three scores. Four hits.

FOURTH INNING

Monarchs—Donaldson out, Dimond to Blodgett. Washington walked. Mathall fouled to Darrow. Washington out on Blackburn's fielder's choice, Walker to Dimond. No runs. No hits.

Beloit—Williams singled to center. Hogue flew to Mathall. Darrow hit into a double, Portuondo to Mathall to Washington. No runs. One hit.

FIFTH INNING

Monarchs — Rodriguez walked. Smith sacrificed, Williams to Blodgett. Portuondo singled through second, scoring Rodriguez, but was caught at second, Hogue to Walker. McNair out, Darrow to Blodgett. No runs. One hit.

Beloit—Culver hit by pitched ball, reached second on Smith's bungle of Walker's grounder. Walker out

stealing second. Dimond hit a sacrifice fly to deep center, scoring Culver. Horan flew out to Donaldson. One run. No hits.

SIXTH INNING

Monarchs—Mendez out, Williams to Blodgett. Donaldson flew to Horan. Washington singled to right field. Mathall singled to left and stole second. With two down and men on third and second, Blackburn hit a

liner toward second and Dimond made the feature play of the day in catching the liner, and saving two runs. No runs. Two hits.

Beloit — Blodgett whiffed. Hart flew to Mendez and Williams flew to Blackburn. No runs. No hits.

SEVENTH INNING

Monarchs—Rodriguez and Smith

struck out. Portuondo grounded to Blodgett. No runs. No hits.

Beloit — Hogue out, Mendez to Washington. Darrow singled to right. Culver singled to left. Walker sacrificed. Dimond out, Portuondo to Washington. No runs. Two hits.

EIGHTH INNING

Monarchs—Mendez out, when Williams covered first and received the grounder from Blodgett. Mendez and Donaldson both out, Hart to Blodgett. No runs. No hits.

Beloit—Horan and Blodgett both flew out to Portuondo. Hart singled, and scored on Williams' single to right. Darrow hit to Mendez, who bungled, scoring Williams. Culver walked. Walker flew to Mendez. Two runs. Three hits.

NINTH INNING

Monarchs — Washington, Mathall and Blackburn went down in a row, striking in vain at Williams' elusive delivery.
