Sport doings of every variety will feature Grand Rapids' celebration of the national holiday.

At Comstock park horse racing will have its local season's opening in the big "Over the Top Boys" program for the afternoon in which five fast motorcycle races will also be a feature.

At Hamona park semi-pro baseball will hold sway, with the Colored Athletics of this city opposing the fast Chicago Giants. Both teams have proved their speed and the Athletics have for several years been topnotchers in local baseball circles.
