## LINCOLN GIANTS' MEN ON TEAM

Santop, a Catcher, is One of the Three Highest Salaried Colored Men in National Game—Pitcher Harvey Also a New Asset, As is Williams, Another Star.

Pop will present to the Watertown fans for the first time, Santop, the

famous Lincoln Giant catcher, who is one of the three highest salaried colored backstops in the United States. His rank as a ball player is equal to National or American League caliber, but of course his color bars him. He recently played in a series of games in Alexandria Bay, but up to yesterday he had not been seen here. Pitcher Harry of the same team who will twirl tomorrow, is also new to the fans here. These men will form a battery, which will be worth going miles to see. Poles and Williams are also new men secured to strengthen the team for this series.
