of 9-4

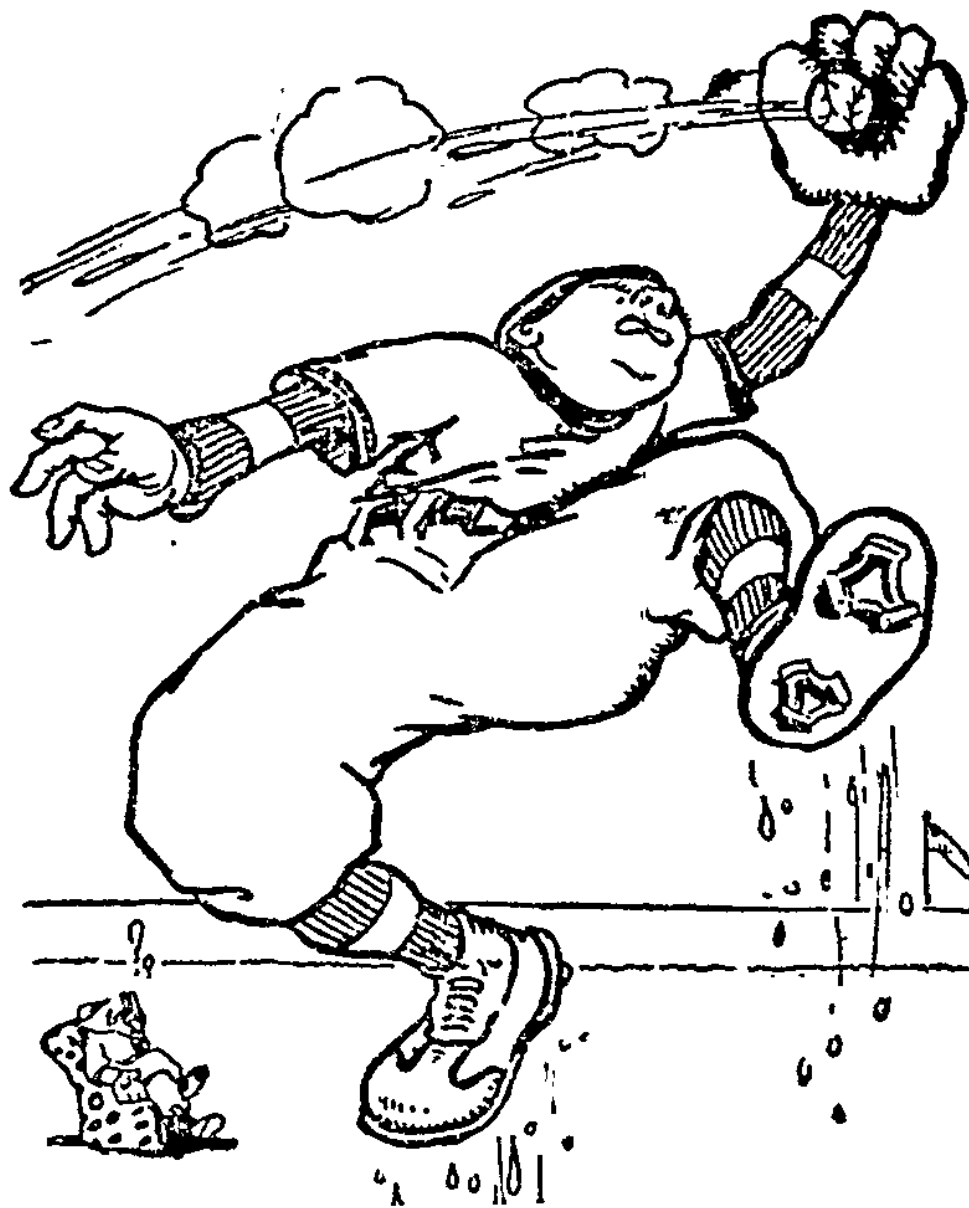
