HARVEY HURLS ROYAL GIANTS TO 5-4 VICTORY

Allows Cubans Six Hits

—Fans Barranda in

9th With Bases

PADRON STARS IN THE FIELD

In a game that was marked by free hitting, brilliant pitching and sensational fielding, the Royal Giants, of Brooklyn, evened up the series with the Poughkeepsie Cubans by winning at Riverview Field yesterday afternoon by a score of 5-4.

"Lefty" Harvey was the reason for the locals defeat. The star southpaw of the visitors was in form and in the nine innings he held the Cubans down to six hits, three of which were of the scratch order.

On the other hand, the Royals found Ballesteros' pitching to their liking and touched him up for twelve safe swats. It was only due to the good support afforded him that the score was kept down. Louis Padron made two running catches that bordered on the sensational.

In the ninth the locals filled the bases with one out, but Harvey tightened up and caused Hungo to force a man at the plate, and with the bases still loaded he fanned Barranda.
