ROYAL GIANTS THREATEN LIFE OF UMPS; QUIT

"Billy" Beal Ventures to Call "Foul Ball" in the Ninth and Cubans Win

SCORE 3-2 WHEN
GAME BREAKS UP

near riot brought the Giants-Poughkeepsie Cubans game at Riverview Field yesterday afternoon to an end. The noise came in the first half of the ninth and for the 'steenth time this season the umpire's life was threatened. Going into the final frame on the short end of a 3-2 score the Royals rallied. Handy, the first man up, doubled to left. stole second, bringing "Stringbean" Williams to the plate. The "erongated one" met one on the nose and sent it to right. The drive dropped in the vicinity of the right field roul line and "Billy" Beal, who was officiating, called it a foul bail. This was the signal for the riot. The Royals crowded the "ump," and for a time it looked bad for him. However, he would not change his decision and the Royals walked off the ground, thereby forfeiting the contest to the locals.

The game was one of the best of the season and was enjoyed by the handful of fans present in the grounds and the monster gathering on the hill outside the park. The contest brought together "Stringbean" Williams, the star hurler of the Royals, and Mudoz the best bet in the Henriquez stable. Although the heat was intense both pitchers heaved good ball.

The locals were first to score. In the fourth with one out Calvo singled and stole second. Louis Padron picked out one to his liking and crashed out a homer.

The visitors evened matters in the next inning on four hits and a double-steal. The locals took the lead in the eighth on Calvo's third hit, a stolen base and Hungo's double. Then came the riot.

The batting of Calvo and Padron and the fielding of Romonach and Kinnell featured. The game in detail:

Royals at Bat—Handy doubled to left center. Pugh was safe when Herrera dropped Munoz's throw of his sacrifice. Williams hit a ball down the right field foul line which Umpire Beal called foul. Here an argument started and the visitors walked off the field. At this stage of the contest Umpire Beal forfeited the game to the Cubans by a 9-0 score.
