

# Colored Pitcher Refuses Big Offer

John Donaldson, pitcher for the Los Angeles White Sox team, who will oppose Jess Orndorg's All-Professional team in the series of three games, turned down an offer of \$10,000 to deny his race.

A manager of a New York State league club offered him \$10,000 if he would go to Cuba, take another name and then come to America, claiming he was a Cuban. Donaldson refused the offer.

John McGraw, owner of the Giants, says that he would have paid \$50,000 for Donaldson if he was a white man.
