ants, contenders for the semi-professional honors of the world, at the Amusement Park grounds yesterday. The score was 6 to 1.

Although the Perthas got seven hits and five bases on balls, they were unable to get a run over except in the closing chapter. They left fourteen men on the paths and sometimes, when the bases were full and most any kind of a hit would have meant one or more runs, they would strike out. Harvey pitched excellent in pinches for the colored folks.

Suarez played poorly for the home aggregation, making three misplays. Manager Meara made a fine catch of a fly knocked out by Bradley in the fourth session, doubling Handy on first. Edgar also made a fine catch of a fly from Handy's bat, doubling Clarke on first. One more double play by Suarez and Bowden was the only thing else in favor of the home team which drew admira-

tion from the crowd of fans on hand.

The Royal Giants worked generally good throughout. Although they erred at times, their misplays were scattered. The Pacers procured their lone tally on a fielder's choice, two errors and a base on balls. Webster featured at the bat

with a double in the first and a homer with a man on base in the seventh session. The score:
