GLOBE TEAM NO MATCH FOR GIANTS

Harvey, Visiting Pitcher, Lets
Tiremakers Down With Two
Hits, Winning, 10-0

Airtight pitching by Harvey and terrific hitting by his teammates acted disastrously against Tommy O'Hara's Globe Tire Delaware River League club yesterday afternoon at the new Globe athletic field in the game with the Brooklyn Royal Giants and the tiremakers were laid to rest under a mound of 10 markers

Two scratch hits were all that the local crew could register off the dusky hurler from Brooklyn, Lennie Frost and Harry Hillborn being the lucky members of the O'Haraites. Thirteen members of the local aggregation shuffled back to the bench via the air route.

Because he comes from the South and because Ty Cob or some other baseball star has refused to play against negro teams, "Babe" Jaynes, the Globe club's regular pitcher, would not participate in yesterday's contest and Manager O'Hara had to scout up Fritz Gaiser to do the hurling. The former New York State Leaguer lasted five rounds. During that time the Giants clubbed his offerings for seven runs and twelve hits. Johnny Newman was then rushed to the rubber, but his wildness allowed the visitors as many liberties as before and the game dragged on until the final round.

"Hanson" Horsey, the former Allentown Tri-State League pitcher, was to have pitched for the Globe club, but was unable to get away from Chambersburg, where he is pitching for Eddie Hooper's Pennsylvania State League club.
