# CUBAN STARS WIN ANOTHER

## Beat American Giants of Chicago on Hilltop.

The Cuban Stars, of Havana, won the second contest of the five-game series for the semi-professional baseball championship, taking the measure of the Chicago American Giants at American League Park yesterday by a score of 7 to 2. Dark skies and threatening weather kept the crowd down, but about 1,500 spectators were on hand.

The Cubans gained a commanding lead in the opening inning, scoring four runs on two bases on balls and three timely hits.

Mendez, the Cuban pitcher, had a deceptive assortment of offerings with which the Westerners failed to connect. He allowed "Rube" Foster's aggregation only five scattered hits. Mendez had six victims on strike-outs, and gave three bases on balls.
