

BALL TEAM WILL PLAY AT MINOT

To Play 4 Games, May 28,
29, 30 and 31; Three New
Players Here.

The Grand Forks city baseball team will leave Friday morning for Minot to open the season with that city playing four games straight, Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday, May 28 to 31 inclusive, Sherman Schlosser, secretary of the association, announced today. Minot will play return games in this city, but the dates have not been set as yet.

Mr. Schlosser also announced the arrival of three new players for the team. Homer Bird, a left-handed twirler from New Rockford has been secured to assist Lee Fairchild in the pitching line and is recommended as a real whirlwind in the box. He ar-

rived here Wednesday. Two players, an infielder and an outfielder, also arrived Wednesday from California to strengthen the present line-up. There is little doubt now but what exceptionally fast ball will be played by the Grand Forks team.

The schedule of games for June was given out by Secretary Schlosser this morning. The Winnipeg Colored Giants, one of the speediest teams in the northwest, has been booked to play here the 5th, 6th and 7th of June. A game is to be played on the third of June also, but the name of the team cannot be announced at this time. The complete schedule is as follows:
