

PARK WINS IN 10 INNINGS

Manager Adams selected Moser to do the twirling for the Park team and the youngster was good all the way. The black fellows hit hard, but the south-paw kept the hits scattered and when hits meant runs he was most elusive. His support was fine. Bermingham made the only misscue of the 10 innings and it was this error that gave the Giants an opportunity to score the 3 runs. It was in the 6th inning with one down, a hard hit went to Birmingham and he had a splendid opportunity for a double play. In his anxiety to be fast he messed up things and neither

man was put out. Then some hard swats scored 3 runs for the visitors.

The locals made 3 runs in the 4th by good hard punching, 2 two-baggers being contributed in succession by Brady and Martin.

In the 9th it looked dangerous for Bridgeton. Two out and three were on bases when Francis hit a screamer to right, looking good for two bases. Wisler made a great catch and the game was over with the colored champions beaten.

Bridgeton batted hard, there being 11 safe bingles with 6 of them for 2 bases. Brady contributed a couple of doubles. Fitzgerald played a star game behind the bat and had 3 hits, one of them for an extra base over the left field fence. Webb was the only man who did not hit safely.

There was a lot of action in the game. Bridgeton had 8 men left on bases, while the Giants had 7 left.
