

## COLORED GOPHERS WIN A GAME

### Alexandria Defeated in Fast and Exciting Battle.

ALEXANDRIA, Minn., July 21.—(Special.)—In one of the most exciting games played here this year the St. Paul colored Gophers defeated the strong Alexandria team, 6 to 3. The Alexandria team had the lead up to the fifth inning when Trotter weakened and allowed seven hits, four runs coming in making the score 4 to 3.

Alexandria came right back undaunted and made one in the sixth and one in the seventh, from them on neither side scored through sharp fielding on both sides, although at critical times both sides made errors. The Gophers secured 12 hits off Trotter, while five hits were made off London, who was relieved by Johnny Davis in the seventh inning. But two hits were scored off Davis, one being a scratch. The batteries for Alexandria were Trotter and Leach, for the Gophers, London, Davis and McMurray.
