


County Fair Opens Today.

Unless the weather which threatened yesterday takes a turn for the worse this morning, the prospects are excellent for a good display at the fair this week and a large attendance.

The exhibits will be necessarily scattered, and all within reach of the center of the city. The stock will be found at the corner on Second street, northwest from the jail, the produce in the Apitz building next to Pease's hardware store, the poultry in the Lichtwarck building east of THE GAZETTE a few doors, and the domestic and art departments and school exhibit in the court house, the same as last year. The amusement attractions are scattered over the streets and there will be no difficulty in locating these.

Every loyal supporter of the national game in this vicinity will find it worth while to attend the games this afternoon and for the two following days at Lakeview park.
