

The schedule published last week in the Alexandria papers indicates that the team is to be kept busy during the summer. The season opens at Little Falls June 8, 9 and 10 and opens at Alexandria on Saturday and Sunday, June 12 and 13 with three games with the fast Spain team of Minneapolis. They take on the Colored Gophers on June 22 and 23 and on the Fourth play the Wahpeton team. Long Prairie plays this team at Morris on July 2, returning immediately for the games here the third and fourth.
