

# NEGROES TO PLAY HERE ON APRIL 1

Chicago Colored Giants Have  
23 Games Scheduled in  
Pacific Northwest.

## U. OF O. FIRST OPPONENTS

All-Star City League Team to Meet  
Black Invaders in Portland.  
Tourists to Appear in Oregon,  
Washington and Idaho.

Twenty-three games will be played  
in the Pacific Northwest this Spring  
by the Chicago Colored Giants. Their  
tour will commence immediately after  
the negroes have concluded their eight-  
game series with the Portland Coast  
champions at Fresno, Cal.

The Ethiopians will start north on March 29 and their first game will be at Eugene against the University of Oregon team, March 31. The following day the Giants will make their appearance in Portland against an all-star City League outfit.

Northwest League clubs will then monopolize their attention for a fortnight and Rube Foster will close his tour with games at Moscow against the University of Idaho and at Pullman against the Washington State collegians, April 19 and 20.

The Giants have to be back in Chicago April 25 to commence their league schedule.

April 1—All-star City League team, in Portland.

April 2, 3 and 4—Seattle Northwestern League team, at Seattle.

April 4 (morning)—Aberdeen at Everett.

April 5 and 6—Victoria, at Victoria.

April 7 and 8—Vancouver, at Vancouver.

April 9, 10, and 11—Seattle, at Seattle.

April 10 (morning)—Aberdeen at Everett.

April 12, 13, 14 and 15—Tacoma, at Tacoma.

April 16—Whitman College, at Walla Walla.

April 17 and 18—Spokane, at Spokane.

April 19—University of Idaho, at Moscow.

April 20—Washington State College, at Pullman.
