

**LINCOLN STARS GET 26 HITS AND
ROUT CLIFTON HEIGHTS.**

NEW YORK CITY, June 30. (Special) —In one of the greatest exhibitions of hard hitting ever seen in this city, the Lincoln Giants defeated the Clifton Heights team of the Delaware County League, at the Victrix Field yesterday afternoon, 17 to 3. The colored players piled up twenty-six hits for a total of thirty-eight bases off the big three, Harvy Teal, Bob Scott and Red Murray. Boles and Lloyd led with four each. Three of Lloyd's hits were doubles.

Brick Melnis, brother of Stuffie, and Brown starred at bat for Manager Poth's team with three hits each. Brick's assortment consisted of a triple, double and single.

Clifton used fifteen players, including Catcher Paul Krichell, the former Newark International and St. Louis American star, and Outfielder Dutch Hoffman, of the Richmond International League. Score:
