

JERSEYS DIVIDE DOUBLE-HEADER

"Stringbean" Williams stood between a two-ply victory and the Jerseys at the Jersey City ballyard yesterday afternoon. The famous colored pitcher held the homesters to five hits in the second section of a bargain day double bill, and the Royal Giants returned to New York with a 10-1 victory tag. They dropped the opener to Eddie Grant's team by a 3-1 score.

In the first game, for the Royal Giants, Hewett went to second when Bisland muffed up his grounder, and scored when Webster singled to right. For Jersey City Harter smashed the second ball pitched for a triple to left. Hoag was out to Webster unassisted. Lennon struck out. Lohr doubled to left, scoring Harter. Bisland flied to Earle.

In the fourth inning, for Jersey City, Bisland singled to centre and stole second as Kelly struck out. Cameron walked. Jacklitch hit to Handy, who threw over Webster's head, Bisland scoring and Cameron going to third. The batter reaching second on the error. Smith flied to Webster and Hewett threw out Harter.

The Jerseys scored their third run in the seventh stanza. Hoag walked and was sacrificed to second by Lennon. He scored on Lohr's single to right.
