

SUNDAY BASEBALL GAMES.

The American Giants, the crack colored team of balltossers from Chicago, will engage in a doubleheader at Olympic Field, meeting the Murray Hills in the first game and the strong Hoboken team in the second. Lew Wiltse will pitch for the Murray Hills, while a league pitcher will twirl for the Hobokens.

A big doubleheader will be played at Ridgewood. The Lincoln Giants will clash with the Philadelphia Giants in the opening engagement at 2 P. M. and tackle the Ridgewoods at 4 P. M.

The Bronx Athletics will have their hardest game of the season at Bronx Oval, where they will play the crack Cuban Stars. In the early contest the Bronx Nationals will face a strong amateur team.

The Cypress Hills team will play the crack All Cubans in Dexter Park, Cypress Hills station. At 2 o'clock the Eburons will face a strong amateur team.

A triple header is scheduled at Connor's Field. At noon the Harlem Red Sox and Oliver Tilden Post, No. 28, will clash. Then the Outlooks of the Bronx League, will play the Riverjawns. In the main event Jack Tully's fast Bronx Collegiates will meet the New York Fire Department team.

A double-header is scheduled for to-morrow at Lenox Oval, 145th street and Lenox avenue. In the big game the Metropolitans will tackle the New London team, which will be reinforced by a big league pitcher, but the Mets also are to have a National League star. Wunder will catch for the Mets, and Larry Doyle will umpire. In the early game the St. Charles team will play the Yorkvilles. On Monday another double-header will be played at Lenox Oval. In the main event the Mets will meet the Newark Stars.
